BYLAW NO. 2, 2023

A BYLAW TO AUTHORIZE THE TRANSFER OF MONIES OWING TO THE TAX ROLL

The Council of the Village of Annaheim in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

Whereas when the Village of Annaheim is owed money by a person or business at the end of the calendar year for services provided, including but not limited to custom work and utility charges, and those funds are more than 60 days overdue, the Municipality will add those amounts owing to the property tax roll of the affected property.

- 1. If the funds owed are to the Municipality, by council resolution, all overdue payments can be added to the property tax roll of the associated property.
- 2. All arrears are the responsibility of the property owners, and no liability exists to the Municipality for arrears accumulated by any person other than the registered property owner.
- 3. This bylaw shall come into force and take effect on the date of the final passing.
